WHAT IS ArtsPlace?

The Rockford Area Arts Council's ArtsPlace program is a summer apprenticeship for youth in the visual and performing arts. Youth work in teams with a professional artist to create art that is sold or performed for the public. Apprentices who successfully complete the program share in a portion of the profits earned from the sale of tickets and artwork (based on points earned for attaining work skills).



ArtsPlace eligibility requirements:

1. 14-18 years old
(13 year olds will be considered with recommendation from teacher and/or artist approval)
2. A resident of Winnebago or Boone County
3. Have talent and/or serious interest in visual or performing arts
4. You must be able to attend *entire* program.

Tuition: There is no cost to participate in ArtsPlace, however families who are able to contribute towards the cost are urged to do so. *Donations are always needed and appreciated.*

Application Process

1. **Complete Application and return to:** Rockford Area Arts Council 713 E. State Street, Rockford, IL.
2. **Applications are reviewed by staff.**
3. **Approved applicants will be scheduled for an interview with the Artist.**
4. **Applicants will receive acceptance notification by mail.**
